- Legislative Updates Kevin
 - 377 (censorship)- The governor signed a better version of the bill
 - We are prohibited from directing students to adopt certain beliefs to pass class
 - People now are not responsible for the actions of the past
 - Any federal requirements are still allowed (affirmative action programs)
 - Faculty can start discussions about topics but can't push agenda
 - BSU has a training that we are going to try and get materials from for our faculty
 - A climate survey will be going out to students and we will probably have to survey students each year about if they feel oppressed and things like that.

 - Monthly newsletter will be shared with legislators, if you have good things to be included, please share.
 - $\circ~$ 387 (budget)- 500K deduction in ISU's budget, 4% salary raise but only got money for $\frac{1}{2}$
