## Why Conduct a CANVAS Pilot?

- SBOE is using CANVAS to support the Online Idaho initiative
- ISU is one of two higher education institutions in Idaho not currently using CANVAS
- SBOE funded the CANVAS pilot to provide ISU the opportunity to review its capabilities without a commitment



#### **CANVAS Pilot Execution**

- Why select the summer session for the CANVAS pilot:
  - The timeline to transition classes for a spring pilot was too short
  - The contract for the SBOE funding the pilot ends Sept. 1
- The Provost's Office worked with the Office of the Registrar to identify a potential of approximately 600 courses offered during Summer session to support a pilot program
  - 4, 8, and 16 week courses all considered



### **Faculty Incentive**

- A stipend will be paid to faculty members participating in the pilot
  - The amount of that stipend will be based on the number of faculty members who participate and the number of courses they transition from Moodle
- The stipend formula being used:
  - A base stipend provided to a participant
  - An additional amount for those who transition more than one course



# **Signing Into CANVAS**

- Beginning December 16th, faculty will have access to Canvas training and a sandbox for course development.
  - Faculty will have access to their courses on Feb 1.
  - Single Sign On (SSO) will be enabled and a link provided to login this link can be bookmarked for easy access in the future
  - ITS is providing an ICON in BengalWeb for faculty and students enrolled in pilot courses for easy access.



## **CANVAS Pilot Training Support**

- What will the Moodle to CANVAS transition look like?
  - White Glove Migration (K16)
    - Transfer Course Materials, Activities, etc. from Moodle to Canvas
  - Training and Support
    - Synchronous Training (Currently being scheduled starting Jan 20 12-1:30 for 6 weeks)
    - Asynchronous Training
    - Tier 1 Support from Canvas
  - All Pilot Faculty Kickoff Meeting Dec. 16th
    - Need to know topics Multi Course Sections, Online Proctoring, Third Party Tools



#### **CANVAS Pilot Evaluation**

- How will we evaluate the CANVAS pilot?
  - The LMS working group will develop a survey which they will distribute to the participating faculty and students to provide feedback on their experience and recommendations
- Once the CANVAS pilot is complete, the survey data will be provided to the Provost's Office and the LMS working group



#### **CANVAS Decision Process**

- Fall 2023, the LMS working group will make recommendations to the Provost
- A campus-wide comment period will be provided
- The Provost will then share a recommendation with the Faculty Senate, Deans Council, and ultimately, Leadership Council and Administrative Council for review and approval.
