

**Academic Program Review: 7-Year Self-Study (APR-7) Schedule
(7-year cycle; no specialized accreditation) * COVID19 Deferral**

Explaining the timeline: The review process takes a period of three semesters to complete. During that period programs do not need to complete an annual review. **The UARC member** of each unit notifies programs in the Spring prior to the start of the cycle. Programs write their self-study the following fall semester and have their external reviewers visit and write the report the following spring. After programs receive the reviewers' report, they respond and submit the response on November 1. This cycle takes a fall & spring semester and an additional fall.
