Other Requirements for Degree:

Completion confers the following benefits:

- 1) ISU waives the admission fee upon Transfer.
- 2) Students who transfer without predetermined courses from degree plan must complete ISU's institution-specific education requirements.

Idaho State University Requirements:

- Students must complete 120 credits of coursework, of which at least 60 must be academic credits.
- Completion of an AA/AS degree as outlined above satisfies ISU's general education requirements. Students who transfer to ISU without an AA/AS must complete ISU's general education requirements.
- Students must complete 36 credits of upper division coursework (3000 level and above), of which 15 must be earned at ISU.
- At least 30 credits in the major area of study must be resident credits (earned at ISU), or 30 of the last 50 credits applied to the degree must be ISU resident credit. (Refer to the ISU catalog for limits on specialized credits such as credit by exam, physical activity, music participation, and experiential learning.)
- Students must complete all major requirements with a minimum grade point average of 2.0 and have an overall ISU cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- Students will be subject to the program contained in the academic catalog of the year they enroll at ISU.
