

TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT

1. This Agreement shall be in force until either institution makes a decision in writing to terminate the Agreement. It is agreed that if terminated, both institutions will honor the terms of the Agreement until all students already matriculated at Idaho State University are given the opportunity to complete the program in a timely manner.
2. Termination becomes effective on the first day of July following the written notice of termination; this will enable any qualified Idaho State University student who completes the Idaho State University portion of the requirements of this Agreement prior to the effective date of termination, to be admitted into the ICOM program in the fall semester immediately following the effective termination date.

Other Requirements for Degree:

ICOM Requirements:

- Must take MCAT and earn a minimum score of 500
- Cumulative and science GPA of 3.2
- Satisfaction of the two above requirements guarantees an interview with ICOM
- Must be accepted into ICOM
 - *Completion of this articulation agreement's requirements does NOT guarantee admission to ICOM
- A minimum of 30 passing credits (69.5% grade) earned during the first year at ICOM must be transferred back to ISU for undergraduate degree conferral. This must be completed prior to the start of the students' second year at ICOM.

Idaho State University Degree Requirements:

- Students must complete 120 credits of coursework, of which at least 60 must be academic credits.
- Completion of an AA/AS degree satisfies ISU's general education requirements. Students who transfer to ISU without an AA/AS must complete ISU's general education requirements.
- Students must complete 36 credits of upper division coursework (3000 level and above), of which 15 must be earned at ISU.
- At least 30 credits in the major area of study must be resident credits earned at ISU (Refer to the ISU catalog for limits on specialized credits such as credit by exam, physical activity, music participation, and experiential learning.)
- Students must complete all major requirements with a minimum grade point average of 2.0 and have an overall ISU cumulative GPA of 2.0.

Idaho State University Program Requirements:

- Minimum 3.2 GPA cumulative and sciences.
- Must be declared as an Idaho State University BS, Health Science with a Concentration in Pre-Osteopathic Medicine, Accelerated (ICOM Track).
- Must meet with Health Science Academic Advisor each semester
- Must take MCAT the year prior to articulating at ICOM.
- In the event students do not fulfill ICOM requirements for admission or degree, students must meet with the Health Science Academic Advisor and will default to the traditional ISU BSHS, Health Science Concentration requirements for degree completion.
- Up to 30 credits of successfully completed ICOM courses (69.5% grade) may be transferred back to ISU to be counted as upper division electives and Health Science major requirements. Completion of these 30 ICOM credits will substitute for the ISU BSHS major requirements: BIOL 2227 & L or BIOL 3301 & L, all Competency Areas, DHS 4426, and CPH 2200
