- VI. CHAIRS REPORT
 - a. Senator Saunders was able to attend the ISU Budget Meeting, where it was shared that the state is implementing budget cuts across the university system. The university is exploring ways to increase revenue and reduce expenses, aiming to become more self-sufficient overall. He is working to get ASISU more involved and to ensure our logo appears on all funded materials and promotions. Going forward, any club requesting funding that has not completed the required trainings will have their application paused until those trainings are completed. The application process will then resume. There were questions regarding the Student Physical Therapy Association, which had its funding approved despite incomplete trainings. They will receive funding only if they attend the necessary meetings; otherwise, the funding will be withheld.
 - i. Senator Vargas Barvosa asked who will be responsible for tracking and reporting that clubs have attended the required trainings.
 - ii. Theresa Brissette shared that the Office of Student Leadership and Engagement center keeps track of all training attendance. She meets with Director Burrell and Senator Saunders weekly before Wednesdays to review all funding requests and verify whether the clubs have completed their training before approval.

 - a. Benny's Funding Request

 - 1. All promotional materials, including posters and social media posts, must include the ASISU logo if funding is approved.
