THE HIGHLIGHTS

- The survey included graduates from spring, summer, and fall 2024 graduations
- Graduates were surveyed over a 6-month period, which conforms with the National Association of Colleges and Employers standard
- 77.4% of respondents are working or continuing their education within Idaho
- 68.6% of respondents who participated in a Career Path Internship felt the experience was beneficial in their job search
- 66.2% of respondents indicated they held a full-time or part-time position, internship, or volunteering experience while in college

Part-time: 11.1%

The emailed survey reached a total of 2,742 graduates from spring, summer, and fall, achieving a response rate of 43 percent. Of these responses, 36.7 percent are derived from LinkedIn insights. Unless stated otherwise, all information shared reflects a blend of undergraduate and graduate data.





