Course Withdrawal BEFORE the Withdrawal Deadline

To withdraw from one or more classes in the current term:

Select Academic Tools tab on ISU BengalWeb. Click on Add or Drop Classes link under Registration Tools channel and select the current term in the drop down box. Once your current class schedule appears, use the action dropdown box to select **Web WD w/a W grade**.

To completely withdraw from ISU:

Use the steps above in ISU BengalWeb for each course in which you are registered.
