Creating a Professional Digital Website Course Syllabus

Course Description

This course will help educators create a professional Google Sites website while developing an understanding of effective educational website characteristics, communication strategies, and applications. There will be an emphasis on efficient and effective communication between the educator, students, and parents/guardians. Website creation includes ethics and support of diverse learners.

By the end of the course, participants will have created their own website embedded with meaningful content, communication strategies, and information relevant to their specific content and grade.

This course enhances classroom teaching effectiveness and supports improved student outcomes by introducing new knowledge in professional educational website creation, effective communication strategies, and ethical, accessible online engagement.

Course Objectives

At the end of this course you should be able to:

- 1. Explain the key reasons for using a professional website, including the pros and cons of using Google Suite to build a document hub and website.
- 2. Apply strategies and techniques to find and organize professional materials for your website.
- 3. Apply strategies and techniques to create a meaningful professional website homepage.
- 4. Apply strategies and techniques to add pages and content relevant to your educational purpose, with the emphasis on teacher-to-student and teacher-to-parent/guardian communication.
- 5. Apply strategies and techniques for using Google Forms with my Google Site to improve student/parent/guardian/stakeholder communication.
- 6. Integrate tools such as a calendar, videos, and other resources into your website.
- 7. Find, understand, and apply laws that pertain to using a published website for k-12 education responsibly and ethically, including alt text.
- 8. Publish and showcase a website that aligns with best practices in regards to usability, accessibility, and professional engagement.
