

Leading AI Integration in K-12 Education: Empowering School Leaders for the Future Course Syllabus

Course Description

- 2. Analyze emerging and validated AI applications across classrooms, operations, and leadership to inform strategic exploration and adoption.
- 3. Use a structured evaluation process to assess AI tools for instructional value, equity, transparency, and implementation readiness.
- 4. Identify and address ethical concerns, equity implications, and systemic risks related to Al use in schools.
- 5. Evaluate how AI tools align with instructional priorities, protect student data, and support inclusive, equitable teaching practices.
- 6. Develop a responsible, scalable implementation plan for piloting AI in your school, including clear goals and support systems.
- 7. Design a communication plan that builds stakeholder trust, explains AI functionality and purpose, and invites collaborative input.
- 8. Reflect on your leadership values and articulate an AI vision that aligns with your district goals and educational mission.
