Red Hill Pillars

Sustainable Idaho Podcast Host

The Portneuf Resource Council (PRC) has the funding to hire a second host for the Sustainable Idaho podcast for the summer with the possibility of continuing in the 2025/2026 school year. This is a 10 hour a week, \$13/ hour internship position. Student applicants must be interested in research and interviewing experts on the climate, the environment, wildlife, and other topics as they relate to sustainability in Idaho. PRC fully trains hosts on all aspects of the job including: finding experts, writing interview questions, and how to edit the audio recording to make a professional podcast. Previous hosts have won awards from the Idaho Press Club.
